CHILDREN'S MUSEUM OFFERS FREE ADMISSION TO GRANDPARENTS ON NATIONAL GRANDPARENT'S DAY

PHOENIX, AZ (September 2, 2008) – Celebrating grandparents everywhere, the Children's Museum of Phoenix will provide **free admission to grandparents** on National Grandparent's Day, **Sunday, September 7th**. The regular admission price of \$9 per person applies to all others attending the Museum that day.

Children under the age of 1 are free.

The Museum's **Art Studio** will offer a way for children to create a special keepsake for their grandparents. Using simple thumbprints, brightly colored markers and popsicle sticks, children will be able to make a memorable magnet for grandparents to cherish.

Directly across from the Art Studio, the **Junior League of Phoenix classroom** will present *Flower Shop*, a program where children will use brightly colored paper to make a bouquet of flowers for their grandparent.

The Children's Museum of Phoenix is located in the historic Monroe School Building at 215 N. 7th Street in downtown Phoenix. The Museum opened to the public on June 14, 2008 and offers 35,000 square feet of hands-on, fun and educational activities for children ages birth to 10. The mission of the Museum is to engage the minds, muscles and imaginations of children and the grown-ups who care about them. The Museum is open Tuesdays through Sundays, 9am to 4pm.
