FREE ADMISSIONS

Admissions are distributed year-round to Organizations working specifically with low-income or at-risk children and families. Admissions will expire one year from the approval date. Please note, due to a high volume of visitation, Every Child group admissions will not be valid April-May. All admissions are allocated on a first-come, first-serve basis. Both group visits or individual passes are available as it relates to your organization.

Proposed Service Population: Low income or at-risk children ages 0-10. Eligible organizations are those that work with homeless and low-income families, children in foster care, children that have been abused and neglected, and children with disabilities.

Interested organizations must submit an Every Child Program Application Form to be considered for free admissions.
