

<p>What is the price for a Group Visit?</p>	<p>\$7 per student for groups of 15 students and above. The Children's Museum of Phoenix requires one chaperone age 18 or older per every five students. As a result, the Museum provides free admission for chaperones that meet the '1 to 5' student ratio. Prices are subject to Change.</p> <p><i>Groups that attend the museum without a reservation will be charged the general admission price of \$11.00 per person to enter the Museum.</i></p>
<p>Is there an additional charge for chaperones?</p>	<p>Yes. You are more than welcome to bring as many extra chaperones as you'd like. Any additional adult chaperones that exceed the '1 to 5' student ratio will be charged a discounted admission fee of \$7.00 each. Please note that reservations are required for all chaperones. Last minute additions will be charged \$11 upon arrival. Prices are subject to Change.</p>
<p>Do you offer a discounted rate for Title 1 schools?</p>	<p>Yes. Title 1 schools will be charged \$3 per student for groups of 15 students and above. Chaperones must meet the required '1 to 5' student ratio. Rate is valid September 1st – February 29th with reservation. Any additional adult chaperones that exceed the '1 to 5' student ratio will be charged a discounted admission fee of \$7.00 each.</p>
<p>What if my numbers change after I have made my reservation?</p>	<p>All reservation adjustments must be submitted to the Group Reservationist prior to the scheduled field trip/group visit date.</p>
<p>When is my final payment due?</p>	<p>Final payment is due 10 business days before your scheduled visit. Extensions provided if necessary. The Children's Museum of Phoenix reserves the right to cancel a scheduled field trip/group visit if payment is not received by the payment due date. The Museum gladly accepts payments in the form of purchase order, check, credit card, or cash. All deposits are non-refundable.</p>
<p>How long is a typical visit to the Children's Museum of Phoenix?</p>	<p>Our average visit is about 2 hours. We have 3 floors to explore and our exhibits are engaging, hands-on, educational, multi-sensory, and fun!</p>
<p>Is there a place to have lunch at your facility during our visit?</p>	<p>We currently do not have an indoor lunch facility to accommodate large groups. However, your group is welcome to eat sack lunches out in the Museum's front courtyard. In the case of inclement weather, please have a backup plan for your lunch arrangements made prior to arriving at the Museum. Additional, grab and go lunches are available for purchase from Crave Sandwich Cafe, located on the 2nd floor in the historic entrance. <i>You may store your sack lunches in a non-refrigerated area on the 1st floor.</i></p>
<p>Is there a charge for parking?</p>	<p>No. Currently parking is free at the Children's Museum of Phoenix. School buses will be directed to park and unload in the north lot. Groups who arrive in personal vehicles should also meet at the north end of the building to be greeted by Museum staff.</p>
<p>How do I get to the Children's Museum of Phoenix?</p>	<p>The Children's Museum of Phoenix is located in the 70,000 square foot historic Monroe School building (215 N. 7th Street), on the southeast corner of 7th Street and Van Buren in the heart of downtown Phoenix. The Museum's parking entrance is located on Van Buren just east of 7th Street.</p>
