Free Admissions

Admissions are distributed Fall-Winter to organizations working specifically with low-income or at-risk children and families. Admissions will expire one year from the approval date. Please note, due to high volume of visitation, Every Child admissions will not be valid April-May. All admissions are allocated on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please know that we no longer provide hard copy passes.

Proposed Service Population: low-income or at-risk children ages 0-10

Eligible organizations are those that work with homeless and low-income families, children in foster care, and children that have been abused and neglected.

Interested organizations must submit an Every Child Program Application Form to be considered for free admissions.

Reduced Admissions

Reduced Admission is available to Title 1 Schools in the Phoenix area. These schools may attend the Museum at the rate of \$3.00 per child with 1 free chaperone for every 5 children.
