To Apply

The Children's Museum of Phoenix Scholarship Application is composed of 3 parts:

1. **Part A: Scholarship Application Form** – this information is for us to track scholarship data, the themes going inside the Box, and your designating pickup date.
2. **Part B: Parent Questionnaire** - answers to the questionnaire should be provided on a separate sheet of paper. Answers may be typed or handwritten (must be legible).
3. **Part C: Demonstration of Financial Need** - Please provide evidence of financial need; a copy of your family's 2018- or 2019-Income Tax Return, an official letter or other evidence of job termination (furlough, laid off, etc.) or proof of other public benefits.
