

EVERY CHILD PROGRAM

FREE ADMISSIONS

Admissions are distributed year-round to organizations working specifically with low-income or at-risk children and families. All admissions are allocated on a first-come, first-serve basis and organizations are welcome to apply once a year. Both individual passes **OR** group visits/field trips are available as it relates to your organization. Admissions will expire one year from the approval date. Please note, due to a high volume of visitation, Every Child group admission will not be valid April-July.

Proposed Service Population: Low income or at-risk children ages 0-10. Eligible organizations are those that work with homeless and low-income families, children in foster care, children that have been abused and neglected, and children with disabilities.

<u>Interested organizations must submit an Every Child Program Application Form to be considered</u> <u>for free admission.</u>
